#### All Weather Pitch for Torpoint & Rame Moves a Step Closer

The Torpoint and Rame Active Community Sports Network has been working hard over the last few years to have a Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) built alongside the YMCA Sports Hall in Torpoint.

The Network has now made a significant step forward in making this aspiration a reality with planning permission obtained in August 2013 for a MUGA and changing facility to be constructed to the rear of the Sports Hall on the Torpoint Community College site.

It has taken a significant amount of time, effort and money to get to this point and the Network is hugely grateful for the support offered by local businesses, the local Parish
