
# **SECTION 137 GRANTS**

Section 137 is a Grant where non-profit organisations such as Voluntary or Community groups and Registered Charities, can apply to receive financial assistance from Torpoint Town Council.

For the Council to consider grant assistance, they will need as much information about the project and why you think it should receive the contribution from Torpoint Town Council. The Council will normally consider grant assistance for specific projects, in other words to enable an organisation to progress or to undertake a piece of work that is essential. The Council will not usually consider grants for the day to day running costs (such as transport costs, utility costs etc.) as this would question the long-term sustainability of the organisation.

Organisations that have benefited from a Section 137 Grant in the past are: Citizens Advice Cornwall, Cornwall Air Ambulance, Kernow Connect Action for Children (Torpoint Youth Club), YMCA, Torpoint Athletic Juniors FC and Cornerstone Church.

Over the last few years, work on our Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) has regularly continued by the town's representative steering group.

Once approved by residents, the proposed plan provides the framework and direction to facilitate the delivery of much needed new housing and employment within Torpoint.

We are currently undertaking a statutory environment and habitat assessment of our proposals, which will be followed in early summer by a full and inclusive community consultation, before a potential referendum next year.
