Following on from last month's report:

Belle View Square: No update as to when the work is to start as yet due to the specialised work required. Chased for an update to ensure residents are made aware, assured that this will be with me during the week commencing 16th October.

Macey St: Work complete matter now closed..

Kingsley Avenue: No further update yet as to what will be the final decision on the use of this land, remains ongoing.

Harvey St Flats: Ongoing.

Trevol Business Park: Waste transfer completed, matter now closed.

Public Pathways: Work continues. Awaiting reply from the Ramblers Association.

Garages rear of Roberts Avenue: No date for demolition or use of site on completion. Did query as to why some are surrounded by Heras Fencing and others are not – being investigated.

Tamar Street Car Park: No date as to when this work will be completed.

Vagrants: Still causing a problem on Fore Street, police aware.

Torpoint Bowls Club – No response as yet from Forestation Team, despite discussions with Portfolio Holder at full council meeting 19th September. Most recent email states "Thanks for the follow upapologies for the delay in response. I am following up with colleagues in the Forestry team and will endeavour to provide a full response shortly" as can be seen no definitive time line but am personally concerned as the window of opportunity for the work to be carried out not very long for pre-planning etc before the nesting season is again upon us. Thankfully no TPO's on any of the trees.
