Cornwall Council Playing Pitch Strategy and Sport Facilities Study

We would be very grateful if you could assist with the following project, which will be very important for sport in your area and across Cornwall.

Cornwall Council has commissioned us (consultants, Stuart Todd Associates, and BELAP) to produce a Playing Pitch Strategy and a Built Sports Facilities Assessment. These two important pieces of work will help to plan for sports provision over the next 15-20 years. They will set out what the current and future needs are for sport across the county, can help to support proposals for improvements and additional facilities and pitches, and help to protect facilities and pitches from loss through the planning system (where they remain viable and demand remains for their use). This study is being overseen by a Steering Group of officers from Cornwall Council, Active Cornwall, national governing bodies of sport and Sport England.

To enable a robust assessment of provision to be undertaken, it is important to know where the current demand takes place and how frequent this use is, the quality of facilities and pitches and other key issues relating to provision. We are reaching out to Parish and Town Councils as one of the best sources of local knowledge and we will supplement the information you can provide with information from sports clubs, league secretaries, educational establishments and others.

In order to capture the information we need, we have developed two surveys (one for sports pitches and one for sports facilities) and we will be very grateful if you can answer as many of the questions as you are able to. We would suggest that this is led by whoever is responsible for booking or managing your facilities, as they are most likely to have an up-to-date knowledge of usage. For the studies to be considered robust, we need as many Parish and Town Councils as possible to complete the surveys.

This is because part of the process requires visual assessments of the quality to be undertaken and while we already have some data on this, and it will be supplemented by your survey responses, there may be some gaps in data which we need to fill. For openly accessible public pitches which you own or run, it is less likely that you will be contacted for this purpose, as an assessment can take place without a Parish or Town Council representative needing to be present.
