Morning Mally,

I've just finished the plans as per attachment. I think this is pretty much everything I looked at with Phil apart from Carew Terrace which will need more thought going into it due to traffic driving over verges which has created some especially poor soil/root conditions.

We finally had confirmation for the Urban Tree Challenge Fund bid which is paying for the trees on the original Chapeldown Road plans we are shelving. Thankfully we are allowed to move those trees to other locations so I've spread them across several locations with the bulk being relocated to the other end of Chapeldown Road.

The planting may need to be carried out across 2 seasons, (subject to service checks), this season (Jan/Feb 24) I think we can plant Chapeldown, Cambridge Field, Maker Road, 7 UTCF trees near the entrance of Trevithick Avenue and all trees in Sennen Close Park. The rest will possibly need to wait until next season (Dec 24) but this depends on if I can source more funding or if we decide to submit a further Urban Tree Challenge Fund bid which will provide a large chunk of money towards planting and establishment costs.
