**Tamar Street Car Park:** Ongoing

**Vagrants:** Ongoing,.

**Torpoint Bowls Club** – Full and frank discussion with Portfolio Holder at last full CC meeting NCH. Meeting with Committee Members on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> December. Way ahead is to call in x 3 tree surgeon companies for quotation of works and then arrange a further meeting with Portfolio Holder and Cormac over finances for the crown reduction required.

**Footpath behind Sidney Road bungalows** Awaiting work to start.

**Antony Road Flats.** Scaffolding now in place weather has delayed the start programme of this work, still visiting these flats regularly monitoring the situation.

**Issues concerning allocation of housing to those with no Torpoint connection** Meeting with some concerned residents over some of the new residents being allocated housing. Have explained that on occasion there is an urgent need for rehousing which may mean the moving of individuals/families to the area from elsewhere in Cornwall. Currently having further discussions with Home Choice over issues raised.
