Torpoint Town Council currently has a vacancy for a Town Councillor

To qualify you will need to be: -

- over the age of 18 years,
- a UK, Commonwealth or EU Citizen
- live in the parish, or within 3 miles of the parish boundary for at least the last 12 months.

How much time will you need to commit?

You will ideally need to attend 12 Full Council Meetings during the year, however there are lots of additional committees which you can join if you have extra time available. The length of the meetings varies, but usually last approximately 2 hours.

What's Involved?

Being part of the decision-making processes during meetings, including deciding where money should be spent, what services are provided and what policies are implemented. You will have a responsibility to local constituents and organisations. This is an unpaid, voluntary position which can be challenging but very rewarding too.
