

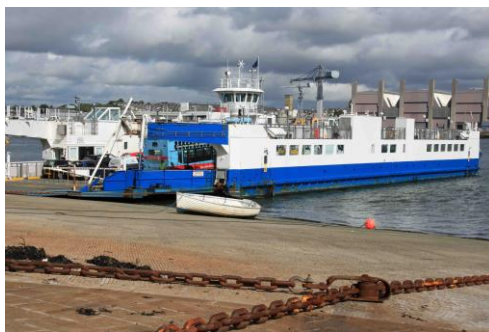

## Torpoint Archives Facilities

### Oral History

We have a large collection of written records and artifacts, some over 200 years old. This contains records and history of local people and events. These are being recorded digitally, much of it available to view/research on request.

### Publications, Books/Booklets and Postcards

A newsletter is produced bi-annually and information leaflets on various aspects of the town are available on request. We also have a number of books/Booklets and Postcards for sale. Call in and see the book you want

### Photographs

We have in excess of 12,000 photographs of people and places from the late 1800's up to the modern day.

The Archives is run solely by volunteers and relies on donations to carry out our research.

## Facilities for Research

We have facilities for anyone wishing to research local or family history.

We are able to research Torpoint Records for persons who are unable to attend The Archives, for a minimum donation of £6 for our funds. We are not able to undertake long, detailed research.

We are grateful to receive photographs either as a gift or for copying and return, or any other items of the Town's history.
