ATTENTION ALL BUDDING ARTISTS AND DESIGNERS!

Torpoint Town Council is launching a Community Project to design a new Town Centre sign which will be situated in Sparrow Park
(In case you don't know, that's the little one at the top of Fore street!)

Entries will be judged on creativity, visual appeal and structure and will need to include the following specifications:

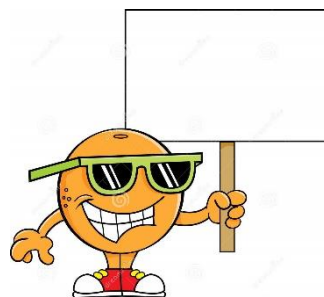
The sign needs to include the words '**Town Centre**' as a minimum and incorporate some ferry chains kindly donated by the Torpoint Ferry....
(Don't worry they're old, spare ones!!)

Overall width **must** be 1.63m (6ft) and the minimum height **must** be 2.4m (8ft)

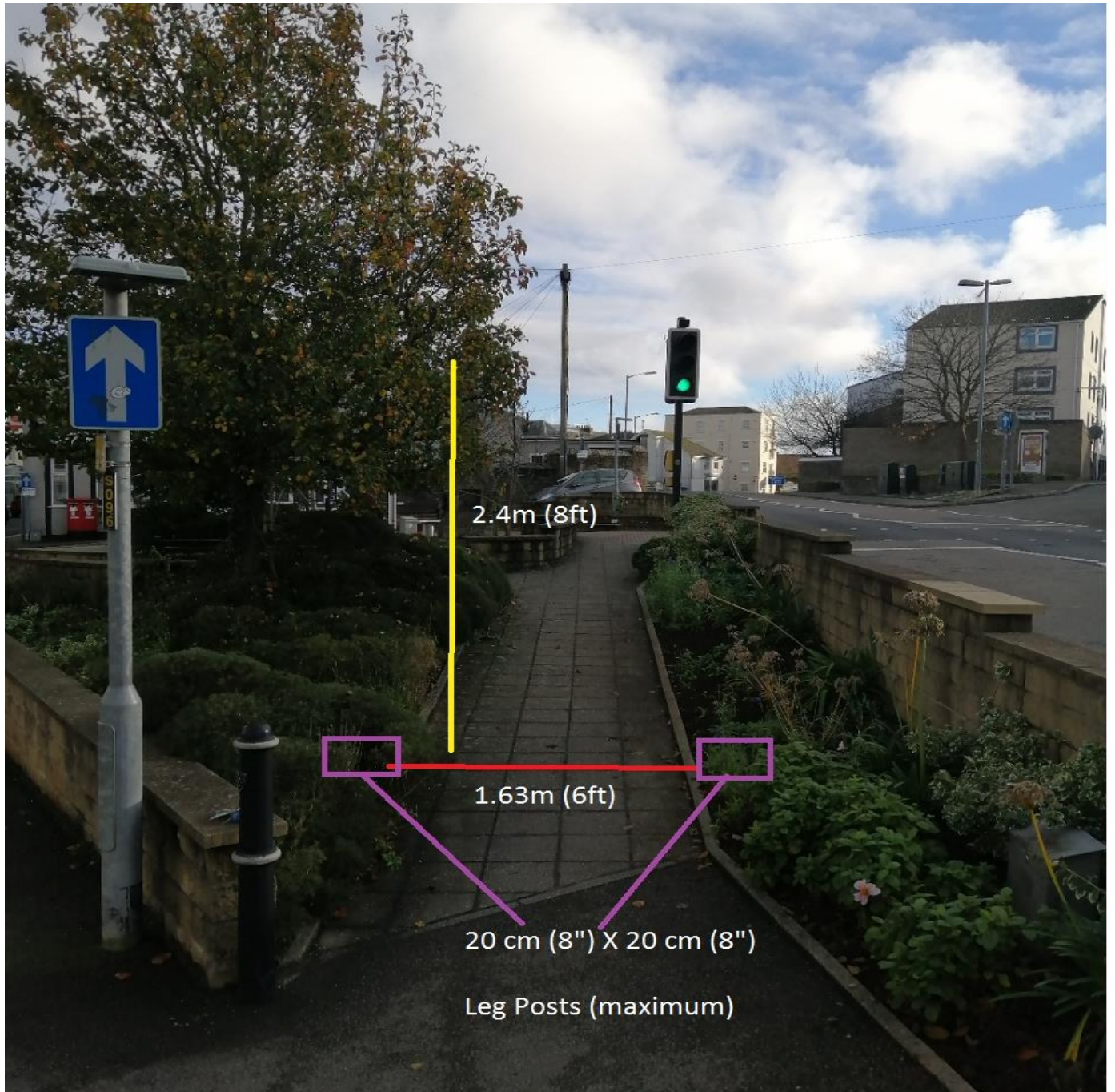
Post bases **must** not exceed 30cm X 30 cm (12" X 12")

The sign will be positioned on a footpath in Sparrow Park so people can walk under/through it

Closing date for entries is **midday 22nd January 2021**

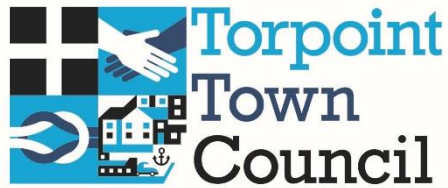

Terms and Conditions

1. Submission of a design will mean acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. Submit your design on a maximum paper size of A4 (21cm X 29.7cm) and ensure it fits all the required specifications
3. Send it either in hard copy to Torpoint Town Council, 1-3 Buller Rd, Torpoint, PL112LD or via email to admin@torpointtowncouncil.gov.uk
4. Closing date for submission is **midday 22nd January 2021**
5. This Community Project is open to any individual including Torpoint Town Council employees, contractors, members and their immediate families. To maintain a fair and anonymous voting decision, the judging panel will have no access to the individual's personal details when choosing the design. (This will be reserved for the Town Clerk and management team which will take no part in the design selection.)
6. Entrants under 18 must have permission to enter from a parent or guardian who will be deemed to have accepted and be bound by the Terms and Conditions, and proof of permission may be required.
7. All submitted designs and source images must be the original work of the person submitting the design.
8. Submitted designs will be retained by Torpoint Town Council and participants will not have any right of return or any other feedback.
7. An entrant may be disqualified if, Torpoint Town Council reasonably believes that the entrant has attempted to undermine the legitimate operation of the Community Project
8. This Community Project is not a competition and no prize is on offer for taking part in the project. The chosen design will become an asset of Torpoint Town Council and become part of Torpoint Town's architecture.
9. No ownership by the entrant will legally conferred as the design idea is being offered freely and in the interest of the community.
9. The Council reserve the right to unselect the chosen design should it prove to be impractical to construct when inspected by any professional body. In this event the next highest voted design will be put forward for construction.
10. The design will be announced on the Torpoint Town Council's website www.torpointtowncouncil.gov.uk and subsequent social media sites in February.
11. Entrants agree that personal data entered during the registration, including name, phone number and email address, may be processed, stored, shared and otherwise used for the purposes and within the context of this Community Project. All data will adhere to data protection and will not be used for any other purpose than in conjunction with this Community Project.
