Please tell us about the project and why you think it should receive the Contribution from Torpoint Town Council.

There will be 2 presentations on the same day, 1 @ 11am and another at 6pm for around 1½ hours, these times have been specially selected to capture as many residents as possible. For example: parents of school age children and people working that wish to attend.

I have made these presentations interactive as I believe interactions with a selection of sensory activities and enable better understanding and allow people to relate better to the topic.

As part of the presentations I would like to create an interactive corner to showcase information, books and intervention techniques and equipment that are available to support individuals living with Autism and their families.

All attendees will be given an information bag at the end of the session to take home, these will include National Autistic Society leaflets about Autism and diagnosis, a Beat4autism pad, stressball, wristband, pencil alongside a leaflet about Beat4autism C.I.C and what we do and a business card.

The purpose of these information bags

is to enable additional reading at home, better levels of understanding and information of how Beat4autism C.I.C. can support them or others they know.

Previous funding streams have enabled Beat4autism to purchase some sensory intervention equipment, branded wristbands and pencils alongside paper bags to create information packs for events.

It is very important to me that Torpoint residents, businesses and schools have a level of understanding of Autism and how best to support some of the struggles and complications living with Autism can bring.

As part of these presentations I would like to offer refreshments and light bites to encourage engagement and communication between attendees.

I believe Beat4autism C.I.C. should receive the contribution from Torpoint Town Council as Beat4autism has been launched to support and signpost the residents of Torpoint - not only the autistic community as many of the events that we hold are fully inclusive.

These presentations are an essential route of creating awareness and understanding within our town and working towards Beat4autism's goal of becoming an Autism Friendly Town.
