

# COMPETITION TO DESIGN A LOGO FOR TORPOINT ENVIRONMENTAL ACTION

## Terms and Conditions

1. Submission of a design will mean acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. There is no fee to enter the Competition.
3. Designs are to be submitted on a maximum paper size of A4 (21cm X 29.7cm), and can be a drawing, a painting, or sketch.
4. All submitted designs and source images must be the original work of the person submitting the design.
5. All entrants must be under 18 and have permission to enter from a parent or guardian who will be deemed to have accepted and be bound by the Terms and Conditions. Torpoint Town Council reserves the right to ask for proof of permission.
6. Entries must be submitted by midnight on Friday 23 July 2021. No entries will be accepted after this date.
7. Entrants agree that any personal data submitted, including name, phone number and email address, may be processed, stored, shared and otherwise used for the purposes and within the context of this competition. All personal data will be processed in accordance with UK General Data Protection Regulation requirements, and will not be used for any other purpose than in conjunction with this Competition.
8. Designs to be sent in hard copy to Torpoint Library and Community Hub, Fore Street, Torpoint, PL11 2AG, or via email to [torpoint.library@liscornwall.org.uk](mailto:torpoint.library@liscornwall.org.uk).
9. The winning design will be announced on the Torpoint Town Council website, [www.torpointtowncouncil.gov.uk](http://www.torpointtowncouncil.gov.uk), within 10 days of the Competition closing date.
10. The winning design will be chosen by a judging panel appointed by Torpoint Town Council.
11. Submitted entries will be judged on their creativity, visual appeal, and relevance to environmental issues.
12. To maintain a fair and anonymous voting decision, the judging panel will have no access to the entrants personal details when choosing the winning design.
13. An entrant may be disqualified if Torpoint Town Council reasonably believes that the entrant has attempted to undermine the legitimate operation of the Competition by cheating, deceiving, or other unfair playing practices, or annoys, abuses, threatens or harasses any other entrants or Torpoint Town Council.
14. The prize for the winner will be available for collection upon notification of the Competition winner from Torpoint Town Council, 1-3 Buller Road, Torpoint, PL11 2LD.
15. Submitted designs will be retained by Torpoint Town Council and participants will not have any right of return or any other feedback. No ownership by the entrant will be legally conferred as the design idea is being offered freely and in the interest of the community.
16. The winning design may be modified for any reprographic and presentational purposes, but without altering the original concept.
17. These Terms and Conditions are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.
