I have checked on site and can confirm that the siren located in HMS Raleigh was operational but there was an issue with one of our on-site sirens which did not sound correctly. This may have given rise to some people not hearing what they would normally hear on a Monday morning. Site processes are underway to rectify the problem.

Although the siren is one means of notifying occurrence of an incident on the Devonport Site you may be aware there is an Emergency Notification System (ENS) in place to provide registered users with warnings of incidents at the Devonport Site and Thanckes Oil Fuel Depot.
