## LIBRARY AND COMMUNITY HUB REPORT

**Income and expenditure.** Please access the income and expenditure document for November 2021.

**Poor IT performance**. The outdated public network IT systems supplied by Cornwall Council are suffering from a lack of investment, and therefore performing poorly. The CH&LDM has been in contact with Cornwall Council IT Support and raised his concerns. Situation ongoing.

**Local Devolution Funding**. The Town Clerk & RFO has sent the costed proposal to Cornwall Council, and formally requested that the 13K local devolution funding be released. The costed proposal was agreed by the Town Council at the November 2021 meeting.

**Lease**. The Town Clerk & RFO is currently working with Cornwall Council to renew the building's lease for a further three years.

**Staff training**. Gwenda Hunt will receive Emergency First Aid training on Tuesday 30 November 2021 at Council Chambers.

**Wildanet**. The CH&LDM has been trying to contact Amanda Pennington, Customer Liaison and Stakeholder Engagement Manager for Wildanet, to further investigate the feasibility of the free broadband and digital equipment previously offered.

**New Digital Champion and laptop**. A new Digital Champion volunteer has recently been recruited. Digital Champion's help people to develop their skills and confidence when using digital technology. Cornwall Council Digital Inclusion Team have kindly supplied a laptop to assist with the role.
