You are invited to take part in a short, online survey as part of the 'Empowering Local Communities' project.

The purpose of this project is to enable targeted capacity building in local councils to deliver long term environmental growth and local nature recovery. We would like to hear from councillors and clerks across Cornwall to help us better understand what local councils want, or need, to address the ecological emergency and to help nature recover at a local scale.
