- Cllr Tivnan and myself have been invited to a meeting regarding the Rugby Club with various attendees from both Cornwall Council and Rugby England.
- The Wildanet installation continues to cause issues in the Sycamore Drive area, I have again fed back to the company.
- I have been contacted by several residents at the top end of Sycamore about parking issues on the top corner (behind the houses that face onto Trevol Rd). After speaking to Will Glassup at Highways, the only potential solution would be double yellow lines along that section. I foresee it would raise more issues than it solved, but I will feed back to residents for their thoughts.
- My Torpoint Surgery continues to be well attended – with residents attending from across my divisional area.
