Cornwall Gateway Community Network Panel TRO

AECOM working alongside Cormac Solutions Ltd, on behalf of Cornwall Council are inviting comment on a number of proposals to introduce and amend waiting restrictions and speed limits within Cornwall Gateway Community Network Area. These proposals have been formulated following discussions with the network panel and relevant Cornwall Councillors.

Details of the schemes are as follows:

Longmeadow Road

No waiting at any time restrictions on Longmeadow Road and Glebe Avenue, to prevent obstructive parking around the corner and to maintain access to properties. Refer to Site Notice EDG1980_01 for details.

Antony Road

Proposed extension of 30mph speed limit on Antony Road and new traffic calming measures prior to Torpoint Community College. Traffic calming measures include the provision of dragons teeth road markings and triangular school warning road marking and a new school warning sign. These proposals are to encourage lower speeds past the school and local YMCA sports centre and improve road safety entering Torpoint. Refer to Site Notice EDG1980_02 for details.

Barkers Hill

Proposed 20mph speed limit between Barkers Hill, Longlands Lane and Fairmead Road. This is to slow traffic to improve road safety for pedestrians and residents within Burraton Coombe. Refer to Site Notice EDG1980_03 for details.



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Ashton Way

No waiting at any time restriction proposed at its junction with New Road, to prevent obstructive parking at the junction, improve visibility for exiting traffic and provide a safe passage for highway users on the correct side of the road. Refer to Site Notice EDG1980_04 for details.

Tregantle Junction

Removal of clearway and installation of carriageway and verge no waiting at any time restrictions. These proposals will facilitate passage along the road for buses and emergency vehicles to improve safety and reduce congestion in the area. Refer to Site Notice EDG1980_05 for details.

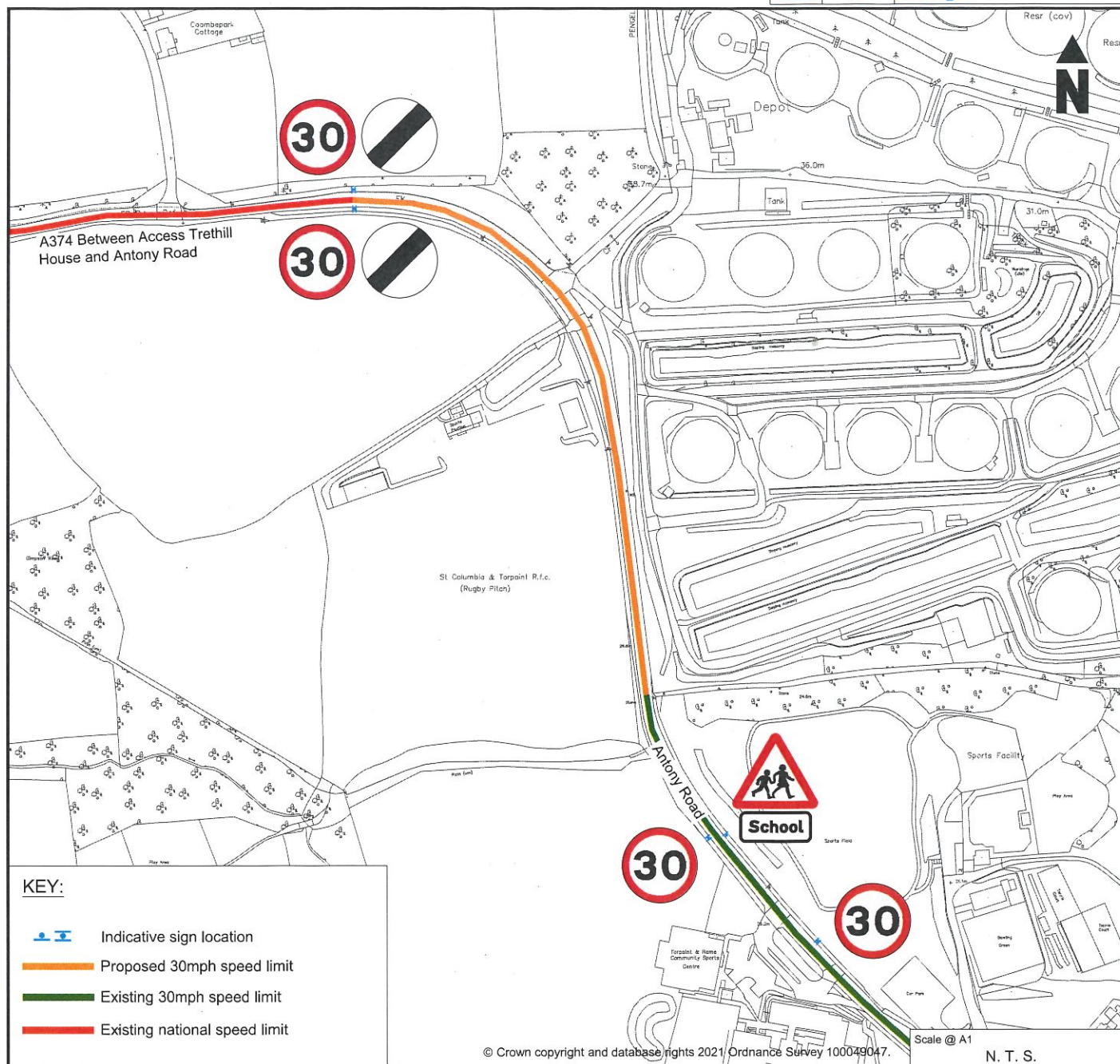
