Councillor Tivnan BEM informed Members he had received a number of complaints and queries about the new bus timetables that will be released on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2022. There are many concerns regarding the reduced bus schedule, these include residents' living on the Grove Park Estate where buses will not run between 9.30am to 3.30pm, additionally, residents needing to use the bus service to travel to the doctor's surgery or working in Plymouth and surrounding areas will also be affected. Councillor Mrs. K Ewert highlighted with a reduced bus service, there will be a 30-minute wait at the ferry as the schedule has been changed to hourly and the buses servicing Portwrinkle and Crafthole are being cancelled.</li> </ul>
