April footfall. During the period 1-27 April, the average footfall was 154 per day open.

Opening times. The Town Clerk & RFO and CH&LDM recently got together to look at options to extend opening times. It was decided that the library would open on the last Sunday of every month, to coincide with street market day. The CH&LDM has spoken with the owner of Kardkadia, Jan Brown, and Jan had no problem with the library and café being open at the same time as her.

Seagull proof sacks price increase. The selling price for seagull proof sacks has increased by 20 pence to £3.70 per sack. This is due to Cornwall Council recently introducing a £6.00 delivery charge per order, to recoup the delivery charge that Biffa invoice them for each month.

Jubilee Beacon Tart. As part of The Queen's Platinum Jubilee Celebrations, Library Information Assistant Kate Jackson, has been asked by the Mayor to bake seven Jubilee Beacon Tarts. These seven tarts, baked with ingredients from all four UK countries, will each be cut into ten pieces and served to guests attending the Sunday Lunch at the Council Chambers on Sunday 5 June.
