

**DEVELOPMENT AND LOCALISM (D&L) COMMITTEE MEETING - WEDNESDAY 1 JUNE 2022  
LIBRARY AND COMMUNITY HUB REPORT**

**Income and expenditure.** Please access the income and expenditure documents for May 2022.

**May footfall.** During the period 1-24 May, the average footfall was 160 per day open.

**Local Devolution Funding (LDF).** All items that were agreed to be purchased with the £13K of LDF, have been ordered.

**Newspapers.** The Daily Mail, Western Morning News and Cornish Times newspapers, are now being provided once again.

**New blinds.** New grey coloured vertical blinds were fitted on Thursday 5 May in the area used to locate the public network computers, and host groups. Preventing unwanted light on monitors, and providing groups with a sunscreen.

**Sunday opening.** The library will open on Sunday 29 May, 1000-1400, and the last Sunday of every month thereafter, to coincide with Street Market day.

**The Jubilee Big Lunch at Council Chambers, Sunday 5 June.** As part of The Queen's Platinum Jubilee Celebrations, Library Information Assistants Kate Jackson and Gwenda Hunt, have both been asked to host tables at The Jubilee Big Lunch.

**New support group.** The Macular Society will be hosting a new support group on the first Friday of every month, starting Friday 8 July.

**May 2022 activities and events.** The following activities and events took place in May 2022:

- **Friday 13 May** - Pyjamarama. Library Information Assistant, Gwenda Hunt, was in her pyjamas for the day, and raised £27.21 to help make sure that no child misses out on their bedtime story.
- **16-22 May** - Dementia Action Week. Guidance via books and leaflets was provided, including dementia related Reading Well Books on Prescription. On Friday 20 May the library hosted a 'Time for a Cuppa' event, and £230.40 was raised to support families facing dementia.
- **Tuesday 24 May, 0930-1200** - Liskeard & Looe Foodbank including Torpoint & Rame Peninsula and Positive People, worked together to provide benefit entitlement advice, plus help with getting back into employment respectively. This partnership is scheduled to take place weekly.
