

## CC Report for the Town Council Meeting 21 July 2022

This report covers the period 11 June to 15 July to ensure the report can be seen by all town councillors with all other council papers prior to the above meeting.

All works, inclusive of bollards now in place, completed at The Lawn.

Another car parking issue has arisen, this time concerning health visitors (HV's) carrying out home visits. Time has been lost on these visits when the HV's spend time looking for a parking space close to where they need to visit, especially where extra equipment is required to carry out the assistance given. After a somewhat protracted period this has been resolved only earlier this morning (15 July), with a full and complete explanation given by the Transport Portfolio Holder and this has been passed on for local managers to follow up on.

Housing continues to be the dominant problem with both Salamanca and Harvey St., Flats continuing to dominate the agenda. There appears to be a reluctance by the Housing Dept., to enter into any meaningful dialogue on resolving some of the long term issues associated with both. I have requested a meeting with the Portfolio Holder requesting his input and possibly a local visit.

Unfortunately, due to lack of numbers the newly formed Computer Club has decided to postpone any further meetings. On a brighter note the Youth Club appears to be going from strength to strength with numbers averaging 25 on Thursday evenings. Again, only earlier this morning the planned presentation due in July has (possibly) been rescheduled for the Council meeting in August.
