If you go down to the woods today, you're sure of a big surprise...

Tehidy Woods is hosting an immersive trail from its North Cliffs car park this July. Giant flags will lead you along a trail of discovery as you wind your way along the path through the trees. Through ancient monuments and wildlife corridors the Flag Trail will tell a visual story of the rare and hidden creatures in Cornwall AONB.

Tehidy Woods, located in **Section 06 Godrevy to Portreath** of Cornwall AONB, is hosting a series of free events from the North Cliffs entrance from 16 - 17 July, 2022.

Visitors to the park can enjoy a self-guided image trail celebrating the beauty of nature in the protected landscape. Giant flags will lead you along a trail of discovery as you wind your way along the path through the trees. Through ancient monuments and wildlife corridors the Flag Trail will tell a visual story of the rare and hidden creatures in Cornwall AONB.

The [Monumental Improvement Project](#) team will be there to talk to you about the ancient Iron Age site which may have once existed in Tehidy Country Park. They will be running a series of drop in activities as well as the following workshops which are available for booking:

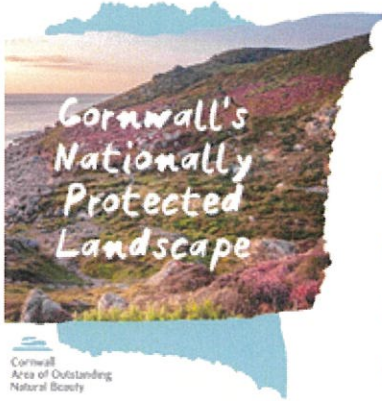

The route from the North Cliffs car park is a gentle incline, and uneven in places. It is designed to be the most accessible for all users whilst in-keeping with the woodland setting. The main path is hardcore with woodchip in sections. Simply park at the Tehidy North Cliffs Car Park, pick up a map from the notice board, and follow the walking route to the clearing where Cornwall AONB will greet you!
