TAHC REPORT June 2022

The team have worked very hard as usual though high pollen counts when it was very hot and a local bug affected some volunteers and meant we could only open for half a day on a few occasions. In spite of this, an impressive 230 hours were worked in the Hub, 157 hours minimum were worked at home and 71 visitors were greeted, including two from Australia.

The 26th AGM was held on June 9th and an up dated Constitution was approved by the members present.



On June 18th the presentation by TAHC at the South East Cornwall Museum Forum "Family History Day" was very popular. Fiona, Rosemary and Tom set it up and manned it from 10am until 3pm and Brian, John and Bill popped in to support during the day. The theme was "Famous Torpointers". A powerpoint presentation with 172 Torpoint views, events and people was displayed on the large monitor and several family history research queries were dealt with.

Five are in Torcare and two are on our bookshelf for use by the group that meets in the Library on Wednesday afternoons. On Sunday June 26th the Archives opened from 10am until 2pm and there were 8 visitors from the Street Market.
