That's just a taster for now!

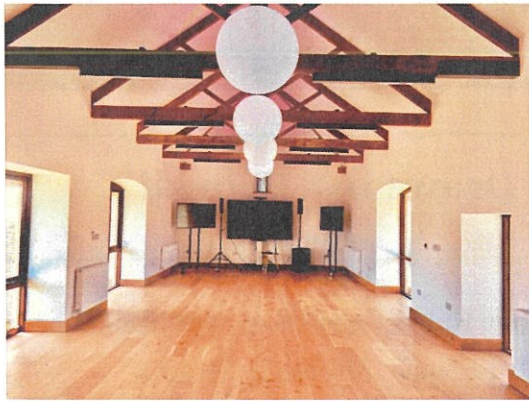

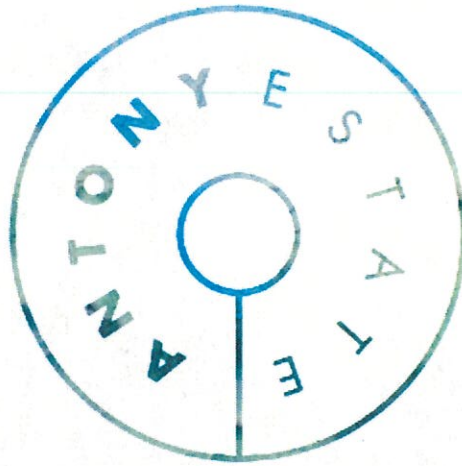

This year, Saltash Foodbank celebrated its 10th Anniversary. It is a project founded by local churches and community groups, working together towards preventing hunger in our local area during such difficult times. The Foodbank was needed to meet the needs of local people, who had been relying on support from the Liskeard and Looe Foodbank. Since 2012 it has received and distributed over 150,000 kg of food and supported more than 9,100 people with over 3,570 food-parcels. It has no paid staff and can only be grateful for the commitment and

dedication of Trustees and Volunteers past and present.

This year, Antony Estate were pleased to be able to donate just under 5 tonnes of fresh vegetables. We hope to continue to support the Foodbank for the rest of the year and whilst help and donations are still needed.
