RE: Accident at Antony

Dear Councillor Ewert

Following a conversation this morning with Milly about the horrific accident on Friday 7th October, I would like to pass on my serious concerns about the stretch of the A374 where the accident took place. I live at Maryfield Cottage, and the accident took place at the entrance to our property. This is the fourth serious accident to take place in the same exact spot since we have lived here (12 years). I wrote to Cornwall council after each accident, voicing my concerns about this lethal stretch of road, and urging the council to lower the speed limit, as it is such a busy section, with many pedestrians crossing the road to Antony estate. Sadly, the council deemed the road safe and the 60 mile an hour speed limit appropriate, which it clearly isn't. It is so tragic that somebody has now died in the same spot. Please can you lobby the council to reconsider the speed limit and make our community safer?
