Good Morning Councillors,

I understand that some Parish Councils have voiced concern about the volume of information they may be asked to read and comment on as part of the Landscape Character Assessment and AGLV Review and the period in which to return consultation responses. I therefore thought it would be beneficial if I provided more clarity.

The consultants (LUC) writing the Review will have drafted much of the Landscape Character and AGLV descriptions before the consultation events are held, as much of this detail is a desk based factual description of the landscape's character. What I and LUC are looking for from you as part of the consultation process is an understanding of the landscape which cannot be gleaned from a desk assessment.

For this reason the consultation will primarily focus on what you value about the landscape and what you consider the pressures and forces for change to be in your local landscape. At the three consultation venues and in the on line consultation, you will also be asked questions relating to boundary changes to Landscape Character Areas and also to some Areas of Great Landscape Value (AGLV) and your opinion and comments on landscape value and pressures and forces for change .

The three consultation events will look at the character of Cornwall in the landscape around each venue, and so it is recommended that if you are able to attend in person, you come to the consultation event nearest to the landscape you are most familiar with. As a guide the following Cornwall Character Areas will be presented at the following venues:
