I hope you don't mind us contacting you again on this important question of how Cornwall is governed.

You may have noticed that 42 local councils have now voted to call on Cornwall Council to hold a referendum before **any Mayor of Cornwall** role is introduced (rather than the decision being made by a single meeting of councillors).

We haven't heard back from your council on this.

Have you already had a debate/vote? Or is this being scheduled for consideration at a future meeting? If you need more information (including a model motion) we can resend the request we sent you at the end of the summer?

Please can you update us?

For information there is a motion going to Cornwall Council on November 29, calling for a vote on a referendum. It would be good to know your council's view on this at some point.
