Dear Sir/Madam,

My name is Ernie Eastment and I am one of the 36 Scouts selected from Cornwall to attend the 25th World Scout Jamboree in South Korea, August 2023. The WSJ happens every 4 years and is the largest gathering of Scouts anywhere in the world; 50,000 Scouts will travel from more countries than are represented at the Olympic Games to live together, share and experience each other's cultures as well as take part in a huge range of exciting activities.

I feel that this is a great once in a lifetime opportunity, to do a lot of things out of the ordinary. I am most looking forward to meeting other scouts from different countries around the world and seeing the similarities and differences in our cultures. I am also looking forward to going to another country, completely different to my own, as I have only been abroad to France before.

Since last year, I along with each of the other members of the Cornish Contingent including 4 leaders, began our journey to fundraise £4000 (£160,000 in total for all of us!) to help us on our way to the Jamboree. So far, my fundraising has included a cake sale, selling homemade crafts, selling quiz sheets, a street market and a coffee morning. I have attended Christmas craft fairs and made and sold homemade dog biscuits to help my fundraising. As part of my group fundraising I attended Tunes in the Park, offering a scout Sherpa service. This is a huge amount but I'm confident that I'll be able to raise as much as possible with the support of local organisations and the rest of my fellow Scouts.

I'm therefore writing to ask if you would be able to support me on my journey to the Jamboree by offering the use of your facilities for free. This would enable me and Lucas (another scout from Torpoint) to hold a joint fundraising event to add to our funds. We plan to hold a cream tea afternoon, close to Mother's Day.

I will naturally keep you updated on our journey to the Jamboree and report back afterwards. We will be camping and training together as a team many times before we leave







to learn how to travel to a temporary small city and be able to cook for ourselves, look out for each other and most of all get excited for what will be a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity.
