While our organisers take a well-earned rest day, why not enjoy what the Palace party has to offer on the BBC.



TOWN VITALITY FUNDING UPDATE

In February 2021 Torpoint Town Council secured £50k of Cornwall Council Vitality Funding following a successful submission to the Town Centre Revitalisation Fund.

Following a town council initiative to create a Vision and masterplan in parallel with the ongoing work on the Neighbourhood Development Plan, the funds have progressed development opportunities at the lower end of the town.



The town council is working in partnership with Cornwall Council and allocated resources to fund appropriate professional work including project management, design, feasibility and commercial advice.

The constituted group, the Town Team Project Board, has approved a Strategic Outline Case, which details a clear, coherent, costed plan with likely delivery partners, about housing, retail, public sector requirements, along with the Police and other stakeholders, located in the lower end of town.

To support the Strategic Outline Case, the group have commissioned further work to ensure a sustainable transport plan is in place. The Strategic Outline Case will be used to bid for funding as and when identified, including a potential proposal against the government's Levelling Up agenda.
