### 2023 Off-Street Parking Order

Thank you for taking the time to respond to the public consultation regarding the above. All responses that were received have been duly considered and the proposals will, with the following amendments, be proceeding as proposed.

Following the consultation process the following changes have been made to the order:

- i. **Not to proceed with the proposed winter charges in car parks that are currently free in the winter**
- ii. **To reduce the proposed evening charge in all Zone A car parks to £2.00**
- iii. **Porthtowan Beach Car park to move to a Zone C in the Summer**  
Due to signal issues, the multi-use session is unavailable and therefore the car park has now been placed in Zone C.
- iv. **Riverbank & Killimorth car parks, Looe to move to a Zone B in the Summer and zone C in the Winter**
- v. **St Erbyn's car park, Penzance to move to Zone B in the Summer and Zone C in the Winter**
- vi. **Caffa Mill car park Fowey to move from a Zone A to a Zone B in the Summer**
- vii. **Reduce the multi-use sessions in Zone A and B**
  - Zone A from £5 to £2.50
  - Zone B from £3 to £2

- Zone C to remain at £1.75
- viii. **Introduce Multi-use sessions in All long stay Car parks**
- ix. **Castle Green – Helston**  
Amend Season ticket prices to Zone C. The charges listed in the order were incorrectly advertised as a Zone B and therefore this amendment will correct this error.

## **The Cornwall Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2023**

Notice is hereby given that Cornwall Council made the above Order on 19<sup>th</sup> May 2023, under Section 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and in accordance with Schedule 9 of the Act.

The general effect of the Order will revoke and replace The Cornwall Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2020 (as amended), whilst also making the following amendments:

1. Vary the parking charges in all Cornwall Council chargeable car parks to introduce tariff banding simplifying parking charges across the county
2. The following car parks will be revoked from the Order:
  - Dobwalls
  - Pendennis Point, Falmouth
  - Freathy
  - Towan Headland, Newquay
3. Amendments made to the definition of Motor home/ Camper within the order.

This Notice is intended to provide an indication of the Order's provisions. A copy of the final Order may be inspected at any Cornwall Council library (check locally for opening times) using the public access computers. Copies may also be viewed at – [\*\*www.cornwall.gov.uk/Parking\*\*](http://www.cornwall.gov.uk/Parking)

The Order will come into effect on 31<sup>st</sup> May 2023 and will be cited as '**The Cornwall Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2023**'

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose the High Court.
