Footfall During the period 3658 June 2023 (until 29/6), the average footfall was 166 per day open.

NHS Cornwall & Isles of Scilly Integrated Care Board funding As you know we now have funding approved. Please see attached poster for our Community Day Launch on 18th July. Invites have been sent to other community partners including Food Bank, Volunteer Cornwall, Beat for Autism and Lyons.

<u>Working with the team</u> Our Library and Community Hub Information and Support Assistants will be taking on a small amount of ownership for certain tasks. Examples are - Summer Reading Challenge, Inducting volunteers and Safeguarding. This is something they has asked for along with further training so all staff are Orange Button Trained (ASIST and MHFS).

<u>Past activities and events</u> The following activities and events took place in June 2023:

Wednesday 21 June, 0940 and 1255: History of Cornwall. The library was closed for the day to host fun interactive performances, full of interesting facts and stories about lesser-known areas of Cornish history. Children from Fourlanesend Primary School (AM) were unable to join us, so we had 22 children and their siblings and parents join us. 20 Carbeile Junior School children joined us in the afternoon. We will also be sending out follow up books and library cards for the children who joined us.

- Enhanced Home Library Service develop into a 'check in and chat' service also. This is to help address social isolation for people who cannot leave their home. We will be giving information to the District Nurse team, GP and Social Prescribers to hand out.
