a) PA23/06891 – Amendment to off street parking layout following decision notice	
PA19/00909 dated 29.04.19 – York House, 3A York Road, Torpoint.

The Chairman (Councillor G J Davis) thanked the Devon and Cornwall Police Officer for	
their report.

representative to the meeting. Councillor C R Sawyer reported, having just (that same	
evening) recently seen the Police arrest an individual in the town, which appeared to be	
in connection with the recent multiple reports of a young male exposing himself to lone	
females in the Torpoint. Members' highlighted the importance of the council continuing	
to re-iterate to residents' to report all crimes to the Police via the appropriate channels.
