

### **OVERVIEW**

#### **Previous Session**

Yesterday saw spot gas prices in the UK and NWE increases with temperature forecasts revised downwards and a couple of unplanned outages on the NCS reducing capacity by just over 20 mcm/d. Although a slightly larger reduction to capacity on the NCS exports were actually nominated marginally higher than Monday. With the start of withdrawal season already among us withdrawal rates were still low at just below 0.1% across Europe amid tepid demand. Curve prices were slightly mixed but with smaller directional movement at roughly a maximum of one pence a therm with traders waiting for clearer price signals, monitoring the Middle East conflict and Freeport LNG facility after a power outage yesterday. Power prices in the UK saw similar movements to gas with spot prices increasing while the curve saw more mixed results. Spot prices largely increased of the news of changes in weather forecasts over the coming days while the curve waited for a clear directional signal.

#### **Today's Session**


Industrial action at St Fergus is set to begin on the 27th November over pay disputes yet currently is not expected to impact production. EDF have agreed with the French government on post-ARENH nuclear power price aiming to ensure an average price of Eur70/MWh for 15 years. After an unplanned outage on Monday at Nogent 2 EDF have now delayed the restart by ten days to the 26th November. Norwegian export nominations are higher this morning with the return of volumes at Oseberg and Gulfaks expected today with the UK seeing most of the increase in flows. Temperatures in the UK continue to be mixed over the coming days yet Thursday and Friday are forecast to be slightly colder than first anticipated. Further out in the forecast temperatures are now forecast to be around two degrees below SNT revised downwards from previous forecasts. Over the coming days wind speeds are set to drop significantly resulting in a ramp up in gas for power demand.










UK Facilities Availability (mcm/d)




#### Aggregated Norwegian Gas Facilities Outages (mcm/d)






#### UK Power Generation Mix 15 last days








#### Currency Movement Last 12 Months
