Highways scheme updates

The consultation period is now closed for the St John's Road scheme and the Furlanesend scheme. Thank you to all who contributed and engaged in these processes. There was considerable objections to the crossing on St John's Road, so this scheme will now not proceed. The design team are looking at what else could be done there, and if there is anything that can be offered this will go out to full public consultation again.

In Antony, the one-way system outside the school is in action, this has been done on a trial basis to see how it works. Residents are encouraged to submit their thoughts and feedback through this webpage <https://www.engagespace.co.uk/cornwall/default.aspx?From=www.cornwall.gov.uk>

Also in Antony, the long awaited crossing refuge is finally scheduled to start being constructed. The date for starting is the 5th February with completion estimated on the 15th March. I am awaiting further information as to disruptions on the road.
