Thank you very much for this kind donation and to the volunteers helping on the day, over £800 was raised towards the project.

Attended the Sea Cadets Awards Presentation evening on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> January. As has already been said, congratulations to all for everything that has been achieved over the past year and more.



#### **Future**

## 189-23 Reports: -

a) Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP): -

The Town Mayor (Councillor G J Davis) was pleased to advise that members of the Neighbourhood Development Plan steering group had met on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> January 2024 to review the updates, following completion of the Regulation 14 consultation. Steering group members' were all content that once the changes to the draft plan and the maps had been made, by the Clerk with Clifton Emery Design Ltd., the plan would be ready for submission to Cornwall Council. It is therefore **resolved** to submit the Consultation Statement and Evidence Sources, with the draft Neighbourhood Development Plan to Cornwall Council for legal compliance. The Town Mayor minuted thanks to the Clerk and all members of the NDP steering group for all their work on this project, to date.

#### b) Torpoint Town Partnership: -

The Deputy Mayor (Councillor Mrs. J M Martin) reported the next meeting of the Torpoint Town Partnership is scheduled for Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2024 at 6.00pm.

c) Town Team Project Board (TTPB)

The minutes of the recent TTPB meeting held on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> January 2024 had not yet been circulated and will be available for the next council meeting. The Town Mayor (Councillor G J Davis) gave a detailed update following this meeting and included:

### 1. TITAN Initial 6 Mobility Hub Feasibility Study

TTPB members' agreed to accept the updated report on the TITAN Initial 6 Mobility Hub Feasibility Study and minuted thanks for the detailed study, which includes information which will be used in future funding bids. The town council now also accepts this feasibility study.

# 2. Bid for Feasibilities on New Build — Community building and Police Station site

The appointed contractor Clifton Emery Design Ltd. had presented three initial concepts, which had been previously shared with members for consideration / discussion at the TTPB meeting. Following consideration of the three proposals: -

- Option 1 Community Hub, plus 12 Dwellings;
- Option 1a Community Hub, Office, plus 12 Dwellings;
- Option 2 Community Hub, plus 14 Dwellings.



The TTPB voted unanimously and it was resolved to pursue *Option 2 – Community Hub, plus 14 Dwellings*.

Additional reports / ideas which were considered to be purchased/undertaken as part of this funding, from Clifton Emery Design Ltd. are: -

- £3,350 Transport report (not required);
- £3,250 Drainage / flood risk cut and fill report (required);
- £ 340 Utility search report (not required);
- £4,180 Ground conditions report (required).

Following consideration, it is **resolved** to purchase the following additional studies from Clifton Emery Design Ltd., within the BUS006 Lower Fore Street Feasibility Study funding:

- £3,250 + VAT Drainage / flood risk cut and fill report and
- £4,180 + VAT Ground conditions report.

TOTAL cost £7,430 +VAT.

#### 3. Town Accelerator Fund

Bids available for sums up to £12,500 Town Accelerator Fund, there is an opportunity to bid for funding for a Torpoint and Rame website, and it is **resolved** to proceed with this funding submission.

# 4. Masterplan for Lower Fore Street

There is the potential requirement to conduct a Masterplan for the town, prior to planning, in line with the Neighbourhood Development Plan, the Project Director will be discussing the scope with Cornwall Council planners.

- d) Reports from delegated to outside bodies:-
- i) Torpoint Archives & Heritage Centre December 2023: -

The Town Mayor (Councillor G J Davis) minuted thanks to Torpoint Archives and Heritage Centre for their December report and for all they continue to do for the town. Councillor Mrs. K Brownhill explained it will be the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Torpoint Archives in 2024 and suggested, that perhaps the council could consider a celebration to thank them for all they do. Members' were enthusiastic to do something and Councillor Brownhill will establish the exact date for the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

- ii) [Cornwall] Councillor J Tivnan BEM explained Cornwall Council are considering changing additional public pathways in the town.
- iii) Councillor Mrs. J L Reeves was delighted to report the veterans support 'brew and banter' session at the Library and Community Hub had once again gone well, along with the 'welcome to Torpoint' event aimed at Forces Families. Additionally there had been 52 attendees at the veteran's breakfast, at the beginning of the month.
