CARADON DISTRICT COUNCIL

Byelaws made under Section 82 of the
Public Health Acts (Amendment) Act, 1907, by
the Caradon District Council
Prohibiting Bait Extraction from the
Foreshore at Torpoint, Cornwall.

- (1) These byelaws apply to land shown edged red on the attached plan, being the foreshore at Torpoint between low watermark of medium tides and high watermark of medium tides, except the area shown hatched black on the attached plan. An area to which these byelaws apply is hereafter referred to as "a prohibited area".
- (2) No person shall in a prohibited area dig for worms or for any other living thing.
- (3) Any person contravening these byelaws shall be found liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £100.

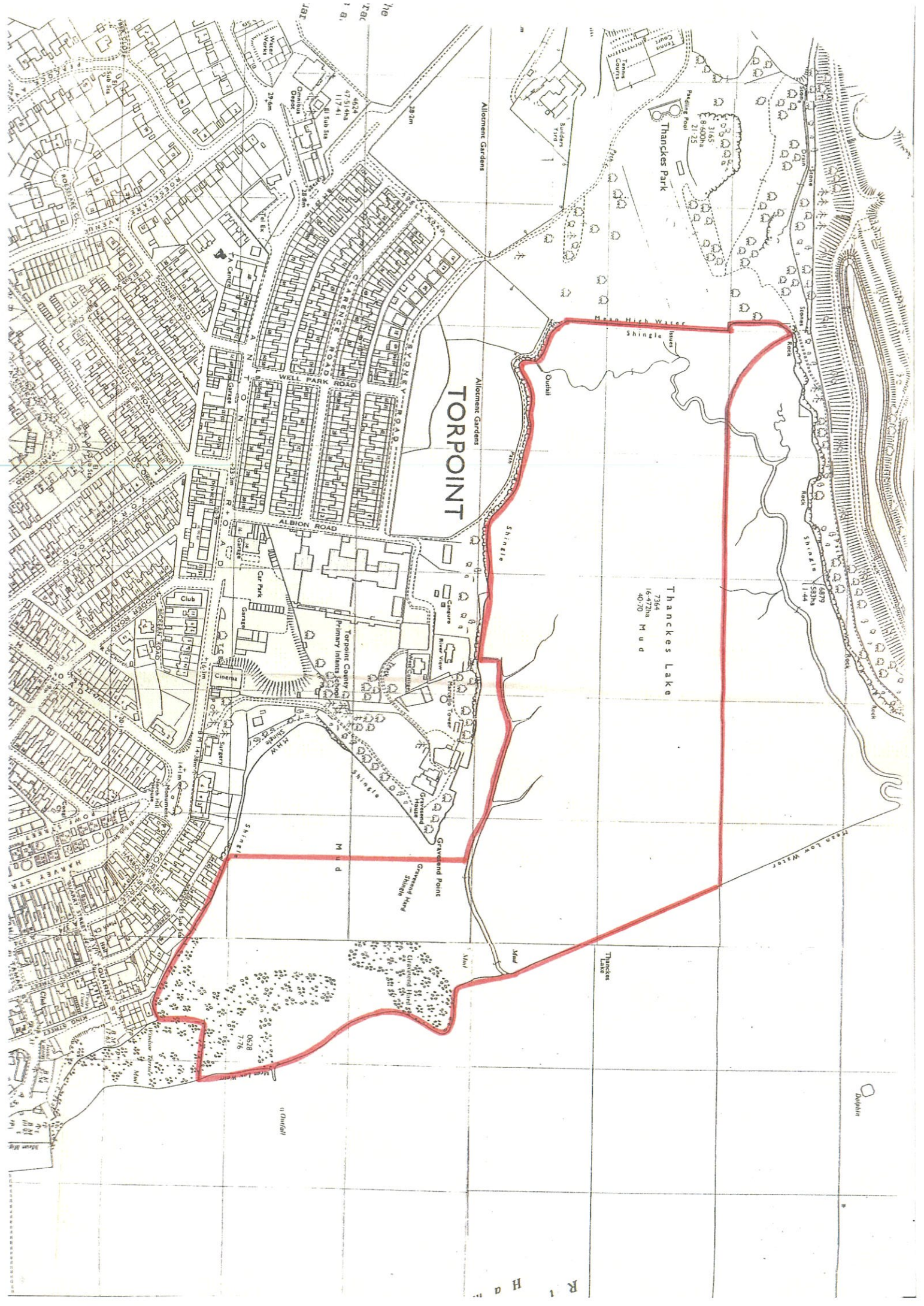
