Tamar Crossings has updated its website to be more user friendly and provide real time journey information for people using the two crossings.

As well as providing general information about the day-to-day operation of the crossings, the refreshed site, which has been launched this week, will provide real time information on multiple individual routes that rely on the Tamar Bridge and Torpoint Ferry.

The journey time information will be updated every three minutes.
