PC Hayley GETHING: Actual crime figures are almost identical compared with last year, although the top reported crime categories vary quite considerably. I've looked into reported violent crimes and can see that suspects have been identified for each case, and that the victim and suspect are known to each other in every case, meaning we have no concern regarding assaults in public by unknown persons. We also have more bullying related reports between children in comparison to this time last year.

Similarly with stalking/ harassment, the reported cases are between parties known to one another with no indication of stranger offences. Many of these offences have taken place online.

Shoplifting continues to be a priority area for us, our Crime Prevention Tactical Advisor is scheduled to visit Torpoint in the coming weeks to visit businesses in the local area.
