I would inform you the Council are intending to remove the Hackney Carriage 'taxi zones', which currently exist in the former district and borough council areas of Penwith, Kerrier, Carrick, Restormel, North Cornwall and Caradon.

This will mean there will be a single taxi area for the whole of Cornwall.
