- We plan to provide teas and coffees throughout and pasties for lunch
- The style will be informal and interactive – with breakout groups and exhibits
- The final programme and detail is being worked on and we will circulate shortly
- We have gone for a Saturday to allow those who work during the week to attend

Whilst we would like to engage with as many people as possible across the Rame Peninsula, we are constrained by the location available on that day - so if there is more demand and a larger venue, then we are more than happy to consider an alternative.
