

## An update on your accreditation fees

Dear Camilla

Thank you for your ongoing commitment to the real Living Wage. This year is the 25th anniversary of the Living Wage campaign - together our movement has transformed the lives of half a million low-paid workers and put over £4 billion back into the pockets of low paid workers. Thank you again.

To continue this important work and cover our increased costs, as usual we will be adjusting our 2026-27 accreditation fees from 1st April 2026.

### Living Wage accreditation fee

As usual your Living Wage accreditation fee will increase by inflation. This means your 2026-27 annual accreditation fee will be £150.


Your new fee will be reflected in your next renewal invoice. If you would like to pay your accreditation fee via direct debit, please [contact our Finance Team](#). They will send you a mandate to complete. Once submitted, the mandate will be linked to your account on our accounting system, and your invoices will be set to be paid via direct debit within the 30 day payment terms.
