## From The Mayor's Parlour

Hello and welcome to this quarter's newsletter which is produced as part of the Town Council's communications strategy.

First of all I would like to say what an honour and a privilege it is to have been unanimously re-elected as Town Mayor at this year's annual meeting in May. I thank my fellow Councillors for putting their faith and trust in me and I look forward to the year ahead.

The Council is currently working with the Cornwall FA, the Football Foundation and Torpoint Community College to try and bring the long awaited 3G Pitch Project to fruition. Having engaged SJ SLC Sport & Leisure Consultants the Council is hopeful that a proposal will be forthcoming which is acceptable to all parties. If successful this project will generate the largest investment in sports facilities in the Town for a generation. Please monitor our social media, website and press releases for further updates.

Cornwall Council's initiative to switch off all Street Lighting between midnight and 5am has been discussed at length and challenged by the Town Council. Further to recent negotiations we have managed to secure all lights being left on over the weekend period and North Road has been added to the list of main routes which are left on every night which includes Fore Street, Rowe Street, Harvey Street, Antony Road, Marine Drive, Carbeile Road and Trevol Road. Although I know this is not satisfactory to everyone at least it is some positive progress.

Highlights in this newsletter include a Focus on Fore Street. The Council is offering all businesses an opportunity to advertise free of charge in this and forthcoming issues with other areas of the town being included in subsequent issues. There is a report on the Accessible Play Equipment which has been installed in two of our play parks and a report on the Torpoint Skatepark Project which is being supported by my Mayor's Charity Fund this year along with Cornwall Air Ambulance. ## Torpoint Skatepark

### Winning Contractor Appointed for Ambitious New Torpoint Skatepark

Torpoint Town Council is delighted to announce that Canvas Spaces has been appointed as the lead contractor to design, support fundraising for, and ultimately build the new Torpoint Skatepark at Thanckes Park.

The appointment follows a competitive tender process and marks a major milestone in what has become one of the town's latest community-driven projects.

The existing skatepark, built around 2001, has significantly deteriorated and no longer meets modern safety or design standards. For several years, local young people and families have raised concerns about the condition of the facility and the lack of suitable features for today's skateboarding, BMX, scooter and inline skating communities.

In response, Torpoint Town Council has committed £20,000 in seed funding to help catalyse the redevelopment project. The creation of Torpoint Ramps Forum (TRF) in 2023 brought renewed energy to the campaign, with a dedicated group of local residents, parents and young people leading engagement, awareness-raising and consultation work across the town.

Over the past 18 months, TRF has organised community events, delivered a comprehensive survey and built strong local momentum behind the vision for a modern, inclusive skatepark. Survey findings demonstrated overwhelming support for redevelopment, with more than 95% backing the project and over 70% saying they would use a new facility weekly or daily.

The new skatepark will be a professionally designed, poured-concrete facility shaped directly by community and youth consultation. The vision is for a smooth, safe riding environment that caters for beginners through to advanced riders and supports a wide range of wheeled sports. It will also create



a welcoming social space for families and spectators, forming part of a wider ambition to enhance Torpoint Skatepark as an outdoor community hub.

Subject to planning permission and successful fundraising, the project aims to open the new skatepark in 2027.

Canvas Spaces impressed the evaluation panel with their strong track record, innovative approach and clear commitment to meaningful youth engagement. They will now lead consultation sessions with local young people, develop concept designs and 3D visuals, support the planning process and work alongside the Council and community to help secure the funding required to deliver the full project within the £400,000 budget envelope.

Town Mayor Councillor Mrs Julie Martin said: "This is a hugely exciting opportunity and much anticipated development for Torpoint. The enthusiasm shown by Torpoint Ramps Forum and our young people shows a genuine desire for an improved facility for the community. Torpoint Town Council is committed to the project and is pleased to be working with Canvas Spaces to deliver a new skatepark in 2027."

Torpoint Town Council's Annual Meeting and Mayor Choosing Ceremony was held on Thursday 21st May in the Council Hall, Torpoint. Master of Ceremonies Town Crier David Green, under the direction of the Town Clerk, announced the proceedings. The retiring Town Mayor Councillor Julie Martin reviewed her year of office giving thank you presentations including the retiring Deputy Town Mayor Councillor Chris Goodman. Councillor Julie Martin was re-elected to serve as Town Mayor for the civic year 2026/27 having previously been elected as the first female Mayor of Torpoint 2005/06. The Declaration of Acceptance of Office was read out and signed in front of honoured guests, Councillors and residents of the town. Honoured guests, included: Lord Mayor of Plymouth Councillor Kathy Watkin and Consort Alderman Dr John Mahony, Mayor of Liskeard Councillor Christina Whitty and Consort and the Mayor or St Austell Councillor Ethan Stephens. Also, Cornwall Councillors Kate Ewert and Robert Parsonage and Freeman of Torpoint Mike Pearn MBE. Councillor Martin introduced Mr Andy Martin as her Consort and announced Cornwall Air Ambulance

and the council's skate park project as her Mayor's Charity fundraising recipients for the civic year. Councillor Chris Goodman was re-elected to serve as Deputy Town Mayor and introduced Mr Chris Goodman as her Consort. Fr. Michael Brown will continue to serve as the Mayor's Chaplain and Able Cadet Bartek Cichopec was chosen to serve as the Mayor's Cadet. The Council then re-affirmed the Civility and Respect Pledge and members' confirmed their roles on Committees working parties and outside bodies.

## Accessible Play Equipment

Torpoint installs Accessible Play Equipment into two Play Parks!

Torpoint Town Council is delighted to announce that accessible play equipment has been installed in two play parks in the town.

Accessible play equipment gives children of all abilities the opportunity to participate in play and inclusive play helps to build self-esteem and

boost cognitive and social development.

Torpoint Town Council committed £20,000 to the project and set about raising a further £10,000.

In August 2024, a Picnic and Play fundraiser was held at Bénodet Park, donated items including line dancing skills, cakes, coconuts, dog biscuits, wine for the stalls as well as raffle prizes. The grand total raised was £856.51 and included a generous donation of £200 from Torpoint residents. Over the past 18 months Torpoint Diverse Advisory Panel (DAP) has been at the forefront of the fundraising campaign. To help inform next steps, in July 2025 Torpoint Town Council undertook a Play Parks and Accessible play park equipment feedback survey, the results of which helped to shape the final locations and type of play equipment to be installed. A large selection of community groups and organisations contributed towards the fundraising effort, thank you to all those involved.



Installation works commenced in January 2026, Sutcliffe Play installed a marine themed wheelchair roundabout, an inclusive swing set and sensory play panel at Cambridge Field and an in-ground

trampoline has been installed at Borough Park Play Park. Today's event, Thursday 26th March, marked the official opening of the equipment with around 100 attendees

enjoying the sunshine in Cambridge Field.

Town Mayor Councillor Mrs Julie Martin said: "I am honoured to formally open this accessible play equipment today, thank you to everyone who has helped bring this project to fruition and as a community we should be proud of not only enhancing our play parks but ensuring equality and inclusivity."

Councillor Lizeta Fellows from the Diverse Advisory Panel added: "To see the children using the play equipment was very touching and shows true inclusivity which is what this project was all about. Myself and the Diverse Advisory Panel are extremely pleased to have led this project to fruition."

Archie and Remy helped with the cutting of the ribbon and Archie shared his feedback of: "good, brilliant and best day ever!"

Gemma Lee (Archie's mum) said: "I'm absolutely delighted to see accessible play equipment being introduced, it will make such a meaningful difference for Archie and

so many other children, giving them the chance to play, explore and be included just like everyone else."

The completion of this project marks another milestone in the project delivery of the Town Council, strengthening the community, continuing the Vision to enhance the Town.

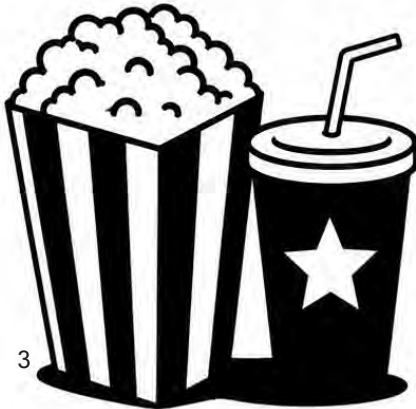
