Hi Milly,

I'm writing to formally request temporary storage for the HPCSH ride-on mower (Countax C800H), following the temporary verbal agreement you kindly gave last week.

As you know, HPCSH have procured the mower in preparation for the transfer of maintenance responsibilities of Horson Field. Our intention remains to store the mower in the hut once the improvement works, including widening the door, are completed.

Cornwall Council have issued us a draft three-month licence however, due to ongoing clarifications of hut service liabilities, this remains not agreed whilst CC review and amend the terms. As a result, we are unable to store the mower there at present.

Given this temporary gap, I would like to formally request the Council's agreement to store the mower in the space you have identified for a short interim period. I understand the mower is already in your possession, and I'm grateful for your assistance in the meantime.

For the Council's record:

- the mower is low-value due to age,
- there is no obligation, insurance or guarantee regarding storage conditions required from the council,
- this is intended as a goodwill / endeavours arrangement until the hut licence is finalised and works are complete.
- the keys for the mower will remain with TTC whilst in your possession.

Please could you confirm that the Council is content with this temporary arrangement. In the event the mower is required to be relocated quickly we will be happy to arrange - please contact either myself or Jamie Brogan to resolve.
