I'm writing to update you on the review of the Community Highway Improvement Programme (CHIP) schemes.

I am pleased to be able to advise that at the review meeting held on 13th August, the scheme submitted by yourself for parking restrictions and bollards at Salamanca Street/St James Road, Torpoint was supported and approved for delivery in the first tranche of projects.

All of the schemes in this first tranche will now be programmed for delivery over the next 2 years and one of the stages will be for Cormac to undertake local consultation. Once I have any further information regarding the programming, I will let you know.
