2.	Minutes of the previous meeting held on Tuesday 31st March 2026 (as circulated). All read, agreed minutes.
3.	Report from the Treasurer Balance in account, £1,138.79. £7.84 banked from Post Office collection pot.
4. 5.	Continuation of Christmas celebrations discussions Phil Griffiths & Cllr Lizeta Fellows (LF) have counted the number of lamp posts along Antony Rd (40) from the Ferry to the Sports Hall building, with a view to offering organisations, businesses and community groups to have a Christmas 'wreath' or decoration displayed on the lamp post, in a similar way to the Poppies are put on the lamp posts by the RBL (JT) for Remembrance. Natural decoration could be used, perhaps sourced from Antony Woodland Garden. There could be the opportunity to run a 'wreath making workshop'. Phil has offered to write the risk assessment for

	this and the Council Ops Team could be asked to erect them on the lamp posts. Other sponsorship could be sought from local businesses. Could extend the decoration to in front of Harvey Street flats, with permissions from Highways in place. Possibility of a finger post sign on Antony Road, pointing to Fore Street. No further update from Cornerstone Church. Discussed the Christmas tree Festival and asked whether it will run again this year. Katie-Marie Martin will start earlier this year to reach out for Christmas lights switch on entertainment. Could an 'open mic' session be run in Cornerstone Church? What other entertainment is being planned over the Christmas celebrations? Contact The Sea Cadet Band for Sparrow Park dates. Pubs? Katie-Marie Martin volunteered to look at setting up a dedicated Torpoint Christmas page (Instagram/linked to Facebook). Accessibility – consider sensory options/disabled access to activities. Continued the discussion regarding decorating a Gingerbread competition, LF will speak to Mrs Brown. The competition could be run in the Library and Community Hub. The Royal Marine Band have been in touch with the Council office regarding booking to do concerts in 2027, so Clerk will contact and ask about opportunity to support the Christmas Lights switch on, hopefully performing at Cornerstone Church.
