Proposed Health Centre Public Event – Update

22nd March 2012

The Public Event regarding the proposed Health Centre was held at the Council Chambers yesterday, 21st March, and was attended by at least 196 people. I am publishing this short communiqué to let you know what will happen now.

As you might imagine, a range of issues were raised, some predictable (access, public transport) some not so. For example, I registered the discontent of Torpoint Town Council that NHS Cornwall failed to engage with us at a much earlier stage of the process, preferably at the outset.

The procedure now is that NHS Cornwall has gone away to collate the feedback submitted by the public; a copy of their report will be forwarded to Torpoint Town Council, I am assured, before Easter. A meeting has been arranged for 23rd April between NHS Cornwall and Torpoint Town Councillors so that we can analyse the feedback, identify **all** the issues and work out a way of resolving them.

I will keep you up to date by posting reports as things develop on this most important of issues.
