J Tivnan is available and can be contacted for advice regarding floats if needed. J Tivnan explained that Crafthole has sorted their Insurance recently and agreed to contact them for details. **Action J Tivnan.**
  - D Chinn has approached Citybus, who are unable to assist at the event and has approached First buses for assistance and will await an outcome. D Chinn offered to set up a Facebook page for the Carnival event and asked members for any old carnival photos which could be added to the Facebook page, members approved this proposal. **Action D Chinn.** This Facebook page will also be shared with members of the Torpoint Topics Facebook page.

  - Stalls G Davis commented that at the event last year he did not feel there were very many stalls. M Pearn explained that charities will be charged £5.00 per stall and businesses charged

£10.00 per stall. K Brownhill offered to administer the stall bookings prior to the event, **action K Brownhill.** The Town Fryer will be selling food/refreshments and they have agreed to donate any profits to the Carnival. The number of fancy dress categories was discussed and a review of this was agreed. A volunteer is required to go around to the businesses for donations or raffle prizes for the carnival.

# 9. Financial Report – The Treasurer

E. Andrews distributed the current financial report and was thanked for the detailed set of accounts presented. E. Andrews explained the £5,000 income from Torpoint Town Council for Armed Forces Day is not included in the budget. The Cornwall Armed Forces Day income / expenditure details will be prepared for the wash-up on  $21^{\rm st}$  July.

It was suggested that for future meetings Financial Report and Fund Raising are on the agenda in this order – **action M Pearn.** 

### 10. Any Other Business

- ➢ G Davis explained a "Tea in the Park" event for 2016/17 has been proposed with funding of £5,000 suggested to Torpoint Town Council, with the idea that Torpoint Town Partnership could organise and run this event at The Lawn. After much discussion, members discussed trying to make it a ticketed event, although the pitfalls of this were highlighted, i.e. how this could be managed. Suggestions to overcome this issue included, selling tickets in advance, with a deadline date for a minimum to be sold. If the minimum number is not reached by the deadline date then the event would need to be cancelled. Also discussed, the likely cost to be charged by Cornwall Council for the use of Thanckes Park for this event, M Pearn agreed to investigate, action M Pearn.
- ➤ G Davis suggested a "pop up cinema" could be offered in Benodet Park. J Tivnan replied that a cinema night is currently run by members of St James Church and it was then recommended that liaison with the Church could be made to investigate this further.
- K Brownhill suggested organising a continental market which could be held on the top field of Thanckes Park.
- All organisations within the town should be invited to attend the Torpoint Town Partnership, ATC agreed to review other clubs/societies who may be interested to attend and then email an invitation to attend the next meeting, action ATC.

### 14. Date of next meeting

The date of the next Torpoint Town Partnership meeting will be Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2015 at 7.00pm in the Committee Room of the Council Chambers. In absence of the ATC, K Brownhill agreed to take the minutes at this meeting.
