The overall availability for the last twelve months is 98.7%, however if the scheduled, and out of our control, reductions in service are taken out of the calculation, the service level remains at 99%.

We could have potentially left LYNHER in service on 08 Apr 16 for the repair to the breaker, but as traffic was very light, it was quicker and safer to complete the repair with the ferry out of service.
